Checklist for hosting your own Cards for Hospitalized Kids card-making event

1. Pick a location: You need to find a location for the event. Card events can be hosted in your own home or elsewhere. It is up to you!

2. Pick a date: You need to pick a date for the event!

3. Gather up supplies: You need to get supplies for the event. There are really only two supplies that are absolutely necessary:

1) Paper--You need paper to make cards.

2) Utensils: You need utensils to write/color with.

Some people choose to have additional supplies and some people don't. How many supplies you get is entirely up to you! People sometimes choose to ask local stores or local charities to donate supplies.

4. Invite People- You need to decide who you want to come to your event and you need to invite them! The nice thing about hosting your own card-making event is that it can be as big or small as you wish. Some people choose to invite people via Facebook because it is an easy way to invite and remind people of the event. Some people also choose to advertise their event in their community through flyers or posters and you
